I PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT



1. Healthy and Safe Habits:

2. Emotional Skills: Identify emotions – happy, sad, angry, surprised, scared.

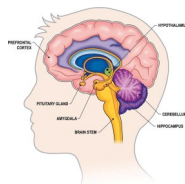
3. Social Skills:

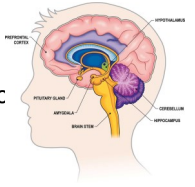
2. Pre-Number concepts: Big/Small, Tall/Short, Long/Short.
