SHIKSHA SATPAH CELEBRATING FOUNDATIONAL LITERACY AND NUMERACY (FLN) – DAY 2 REPORT ON ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

The school has conducted various activities for celebrating Foundational Literacy and Numeracy Day. The activities focus on improving the skills of reading and comprehending text, writing efficiently and performing simple arithmetic operations.

Activities:

- 1. **Poetry Recitation during Morning Assembly:** Mr Sona Thangmuansang Ngaihte of Class V/C, Roll No 49 recites the poem, "Where the Mind Is without Fear" by Rabindranath Tagore to promote awareness and the importance of literacy skills among the students.
- 2. **Story-telling Session:** A story-telling session/puppet show is organized for students of Foundational Stage and Preparatory Stage in the Kids' Reading Room. Students are made to sit on mats on the floor, and the story came to life with the use of puppets monkey, giraffe and crocodile. Afterwards, students are also given the opportunity to share their own experiences through story-telling.

3. Building Numeracy Skills in Math Lab: Multiplication and Measurement.

To build the skills of students of Preparatory Stage in simple arithmetic and computational ability, they were given the opportunity to have a hands-on experience in the Math Lab. Activities for Measurement using actual measuring scales for height and weight are used by the students themselves to take the scale of their own classmates.

Also, concept of multiplication is taught in a simplified manner using match-stick.

4. **Reading Activities:** In the Kids' Reading Room, students are allowed to pick any book of their choice and read by themselves. The Asst Librarian does intervene when necessary to assist students struggling with reading.

5. Display of Numbers and Geometrical Shapes:

As a part of the celebration, various geometrical shapes in 3D and Numbers are put on display in the school.
